### **JUNIOR WILDCAT BASEBALL ACADEMY: (MONDAY & WEDNESDAY) JANUARY 9-FEB 29 FOR BOYS IN GRADES ONE THROUGH FIVE**

Future Wildcat Baseball players will master the basic skills of throwing, catching, hitting, fielding and base running through drills and fun games. Basic team strategies will also be taught. Advanced skills such as pitching, positional play and bunting will be taught where appropriate. Players will be separated by Grade and or Skill level to ensure a safe environment, maximize fun, and be taught at an appropriate skill level.

*Keith Romer and David Noyce will lead the baseball academy. Coach Romer is in his second year as WSA's Varsity Baseball Coach and also serves as the Sports Academy Director. He has more than 17 years of experience as a collegiate and high school coach. He has worked for various professional organizations, including the Chicago White Sox Training Centers, as a lead baseball instructor. David Noyce is an Atlanta native and pitched seven professional seasons with the Florida Marlins, Chicago Cubs and Arizona Diamondbacks organizations. He earned numerous professional awards, including Midwest League All-Star and Best Left-Handed Starter, Florida Marlins Organizational Pitcher of the Month, and winning the Florida State League Championship. He was a Mizuno and Baseball America All-American as a collegiate player at Furman University, as well as a prestigious Cape Cod League All-Star, winning the Cape Cod League Championship.*

Future Wildcat Soccer players will be indoctrinated into the excellent WSA soccer culture through high-level instruction and game play. Skill development and game strategy will be emphasized in a fun and challenging environment.

Coach Freace holds an Advanced National Diploma from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.*
