

SPECIAL SUMMER PROGRAMS 2012

DRIVERS EDUCATION

Westminster Summer Programs offers Drivers Education to students who will be at least 15 years old by July 15, 2012. Certified drivers education instructor and Westminster assistant soccer coach Russ Gladden will be the instructor for this class. The class includes 30 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of driving time, all instructional materials and all fees associated with this course. The 30 hours of classroom instruction will take place May 29-June 1, at the Westminster Upper School. The classroom instruction attendance is mandatory to participate in the program and will not be offered at any other point during the summer. Driving hours will be scheduled around the student's summer schedule during the first week of class. Students will generally be placed in groups of three for driving hours and grouped according to availability, vacation schedule and driving experience, when possible. Enrollment is limited to the first 30 students who complete the online registration form and turn in the \$50 deposit. Full payment for this class is due by May 1, 2012.

UPPER SCHOOL WILDERNESS AND CANOE TRIP

As a school, we are opening this adventure trip to young men going in to grades 10-12, who want to hone their wilderness skills and enjoy the beauty and challenges of nature. The trip will take place between July 6-15 (exact dates TBA) for seven days and will be led by our Upper School Principal, Mr. Johnson, along with another leader. Mr. Johnson is well versed with the BWCAW as he has guided three previous Westminster trips through this wilderness along with personal experiences as well. Space is limited, so sign up today!
